During her 30-year career with the district, she has been a classroom teacher, reading specialist, language arts coordinator, and staff development executive director. Experience 20 instructional strategies (based on brain research) that maximize memory and minimize forgetting. Increase learning for all students, including those at-risk and in poverty, when strategies like drawing, metaphor, movement, music, and storytelling are used to teach curriculum objectives and meet international standards. Explore research that shows why these strategies are preferable to others. If your students are not learning the way you are teaching them, then you must teach them the way they learn!
